Now, a new iPhone application allows you to tour Georgia historical sites with more ease.

The Georgia Historical Society unveiled the app Wednesday. When you open it up anywhere in Georgia, it recognizes where you are. It then gives you directions to nearby historical markers along with photos and details about the site.

You can also search sites by keyword and develop four routes of multiple places. Savannah's Smack Dab Studios developed the software.
