The Volunteer of the Year Award recognizes individuals who have selflessly contributed their time and resources to advance the mission of GHS to collect, examine and teach Georgia history.

It is named in honor of Sarah Pinckney, whose devotion over many years set the standard for volunteering at GHS. The award will be presented to Jackson at GHS's 173rd Annual Membership Meeting and Garden Party on May 17.
