Task Description

Part A: Guided Reading

Guided Reading Questions

- Before World War I, who primarily raised chickens and why?
- What changes led to farmers raising large flocks of chickens for profit?
- How did the Agricultural Adjustment Act and mechanization influence the number and size of farms?
- How did the Rural Electrification Act change the poultry industry?
- Who benefited from mechanization? What were the consequences of mechanization?
- What effect did World War II have on the poultry industry?
- What effect did World War II have on Georgia's population?
- How did the development of corporate farms influence the location of Georgia's poultry industry?
- What effect did the labor shortages in the 1980s have on Georgia's population?
